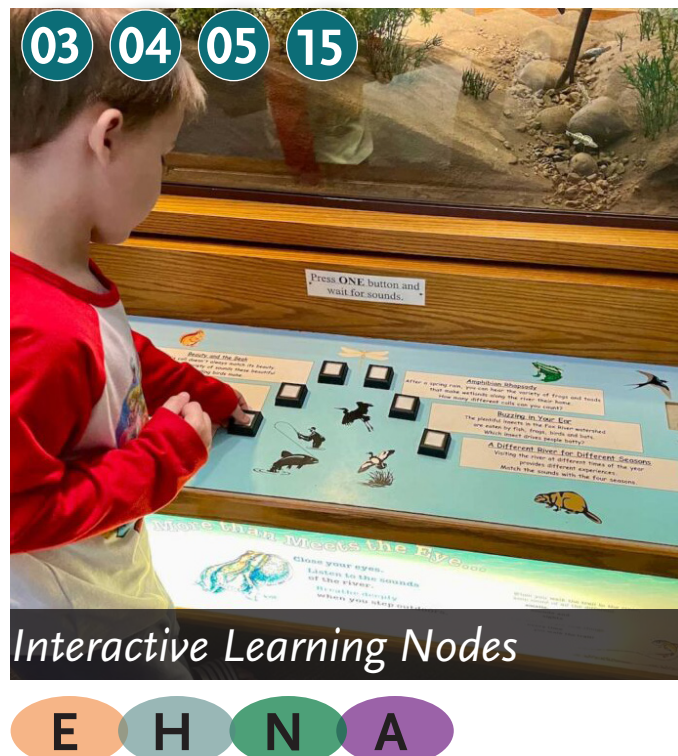
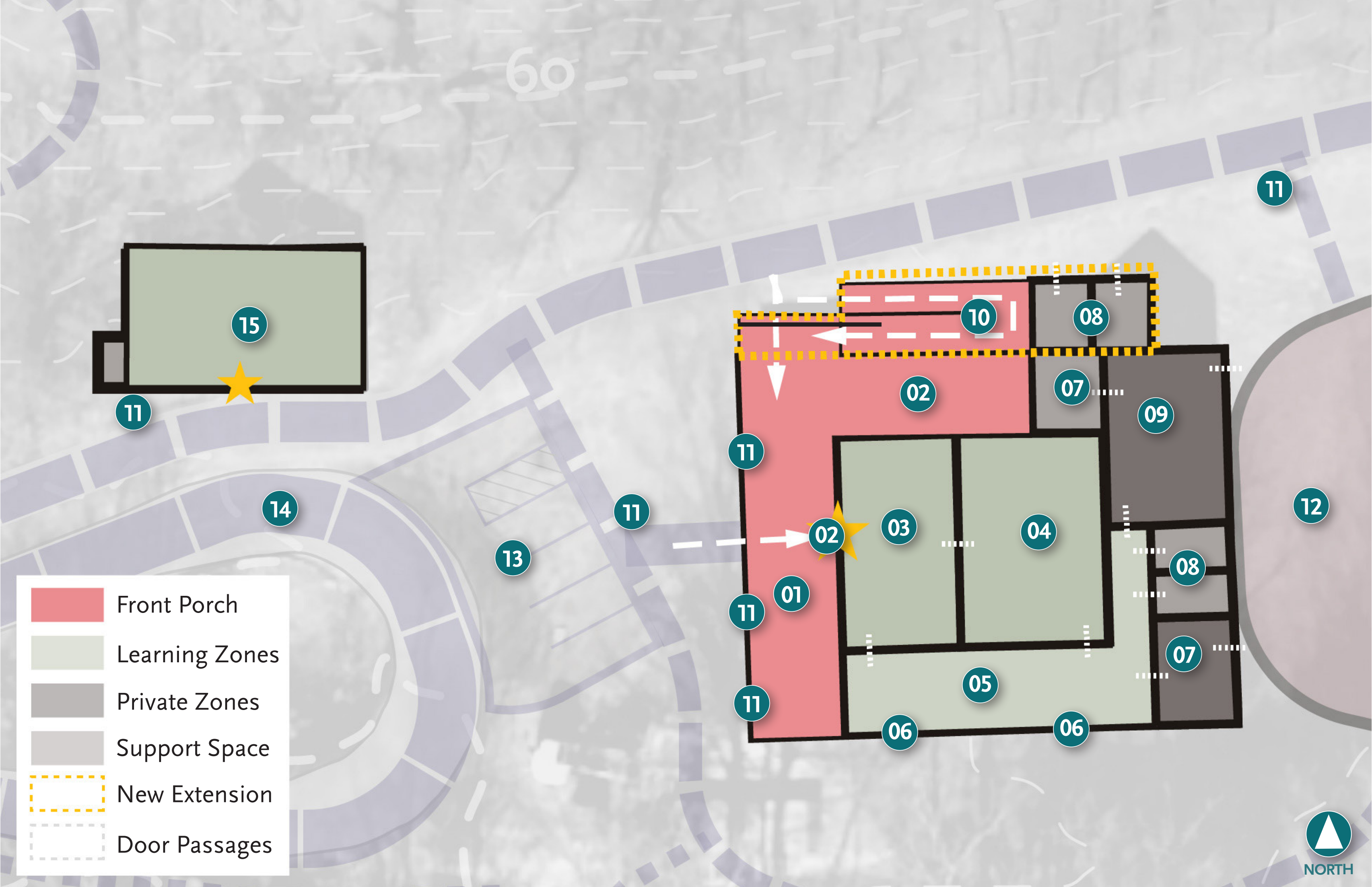


GARRISON HOUSE - CONCEPTUAL PLAN

The proposed Garrison House will be a rediscovery as a meaningful part of the Ozarks. Through the four drivers (Education, History, Nature & Ecology, and Accessibility), an interpretive center will anchor this park as part of Ozark's history and connection with nature. The Garrison House will be updated to today's standards including various improvements such as but not limited to updated lighting, heating & cooling, and accessibility. General improvements to the exterior will restore and refurbish the house and fit the narrative of the area. Meanwhile, the Barn's interiors will be updated to focus on STEM activities (Agriculture) and will allow visitors of all ages to learn how interconnected invasive removal, native restoration, and wildlife plays a major role in the Ozarks.

General Exterior Improvements

The exterior of the barn and house will be updated to reflect the original aesthetic and memories of the past, while establishing a path to the future of this park. Elements will be replaced to be familiar and harmonious with other park buildings in Ozark and the park. Additional lighting and signage around the house will make it a gathering point and wayfinding element.



Updating and Refurbishing of the Interior

The interior of the Garrison House will be retrofitted with new mechanical, electrical, and plumbing. The interiors will embody the atmosphere of the park and create moments for visitors to navigate and explore. The facility will be welcoming to adults and children alike. Preserving and emulating historical elements of the original design will pay homage to the past. The barn atmosphere will be preserved and strengthened to include materials that allow for learning and skill-building.



Connecting with the Landscape

The original home maintained beautiful, natural landscaping. The house will be part of the landscape and blend with the balance of the park. Windows overlook gardens and the forest and create opportunities to view how birds, animals, and plants interact and revolve around each other. Minimal parking provides accessibility while maintaining balance between people and the land. Accessible paths and outdoor classrooms allow the Garrison House to stretch beyond its doors.
